Federal Update

DOT Funding CR

The Department of Transportation, as well as several other Departments, is currently being funded by a short-term Continuing Resolution because Congress failed to pass the FY 19 funding bill before the end of the FY 18 fiscal year. This will result in lower funding in 2019 than was promised in the FAST Act because the annual increases must be appropriated each year by Congress. Congressional leaders have said they plan to continue taking up appropriations bills in the lame duck session and it is possible that the USDOT bill will be one of those taken up. [More](#)

FAA Reauthorization

The Senate approved a five-year FAA authorization bill that represents an agreement reached between the House and the Senate. The House has already approved the bill, so it will now go to the President's desk for approval. [More](#)
