Adam Sedgewick serves as a senior information technology policy advisor at the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), an agency of the Department of

Commerce. He represents NIST on the Department of Commerce Internet Policy Task Force, advises NIST leadership on cybersecurity issues, and coordinates information technology projects with NIST's critical partners in the federal arena including the Chief Information Officer's Council, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), and the National Security staff.

Sedgewick led NIST's project to develop the cybersecurity framework for critical infrastructure. Previously, he was senior advisor to the Federal Chief Information Officer Council, coordinating cross-agency initiatives and helping implement OMB policy and directives.



Brian Hengesbaugh provides advice to a wide range of global online businesses, pharmaceutical companies, health care providers, manufacturers, financial institutions, sourcing providers, retail companies, and other organizations

regarding the legal aspects of global privacy and data protection, data security, information technology, and related restrictions on data collection and movement. He focuses on these issues in the context of: data security breach and incident response, global company operations and applications, including websites, mobile, and e-commerce applications; sourcing and corporate

transactions; and litigation, internal investigations, and government inquiries.
